

Q4 If your business is in Bolinas, how long have you done business in this town?





Q9 If you answered yes to question #8, do you use your off street parking?



Q10 If you answered yes to question #8, is your off street parking ever blocked by parked cars, and, if yes, how often?





Q13 How long does it generally take you to park in Downtown Bolinas on weekends?



Q14 How long did it take you to park in Downtown Bolinas in 2006?







Q17 What months of the year are worst for parking (choose up to five)?








