A Special Meeting of the Board of Directors
October 11, 2021 12:00 p.m. (noon)

This is a special meeting of the Board of Directors to be held at the Arroyo Hondo Creek lower diversion point, which is accessed via a fire road off of Mesa Road approximately ½ mile past the Coast Guard Station. The meeting will begin promptly at 12:00 p.m. noon at the entrance to the fire road and attendees will walk to the lower diversion point from there. No non-BCPUD utility vehicles are allowed on the fire road, so all meeting attendees should plan to park either in one of the limited number of spaces outside the fire road gate or at the Palomarin Field Station (approximately ¼ mile past the fire road) such that you are at the entrance to the fire road by no later than 12:00 p.m. noon. Please wear comfortable walking shoes and appropriate clothing and be prepared to walk for approximately 25 minutes along the unpaved fire road to the lower diversion point (and the same distance back to Mesa Road and/or your parking place after the meeting).

This special meeting will be held entirely outdoors. All attendees are required to observe social distancing requirements and also wear/bring face coverings in the event it is not possible to maintain appropriate social distance from other attendees.
