AGENDA

1. Call to Order. At 4:00 pm using zoom
2. Roll. All members present except Judith Shaw. Two visitors present.
3. Confirm plan for proposed Committee member downtown “walk through” with Department of Public Works [DPW] staff to assess pedestrian safety issues. Members had attempted to arrange the walk for a Friday when there are more people on the street and maybe a big surf. However, while Carey Lando, DPW Senior Project Planner said that they would be happy to participate, the dates that were proposed did not work. She is now on vacation and will return October 18, at which time member Hirsch will work to set up new date. BCPUD Board member Don Smith has been asked to participate.

Regarding the list of talking points. Seven were reviewed by the committee. Bicycle parking was added. Member Minvielle wanted to emphasize that the downtown streets should receive special consideration and parking should be better managed as they are pedestrian streets. Additionally striping of parking places (on the list) gives us a legal number of parking places and helps to control the size of vehicles. It was emphasized by several members that the walk from the bicycle path on Olema-Bolinas Rd to downtown is highly dangerous for pedestrians. The full list of pedestrian safety issues to be discussed with DPW, and their response, will be reported subsequent to the walk.

4. Status of Measure X renewal. At this date, we are expecting to hear an update on this matter very soon.
5. Update regarding development of options for permit parking plan. Committee members are still working on this list. Once finalized, the intent is to share this list with the County in order to determine the feasibility of all possible options related to a permit parking program. Subsequent to obtaining this information, further discussion with the greater community will be possible. A meeting with Supervisor Rodoni to discuss this matter is expected.
6. Approve Minutes of September 15, 2021 meeting. Approved unanimously.
7. Community Expression (for items germane to this committee but not on the agenda). Two residents from Wharf Rd, expressed their appreciation for the committee’s work.
