# Low Population Waiver Application for Cities or Special Districts Providing Solid Waste Collection Services

CalRecycle is providing this form as a convenience to assist cities or special districts providing solid waste collection services for purposes of applying for low population waivers under 14 CCR 18984.12(a) or SB 613 (Seyarto, Chapter 878, Statutes of 2023). Use of this form is optional and not a regulatory requirement.

A jurisdiction (city or special district providing solid waste collection services) may apply to CalRecycle for a waiver for some or all of its generators from some or all of the requirements of Article 3 in 14 CCR 18984 through 18984.13.

To qualify for a low population waiver, the following must apply to the jurisdiction:

- The jurisdiction disposed less than 5,000 tons of solid waste in 2014.
- The jurisdiction has a total population of less than 7,500 people.

CalRecycle-approved waivers are valid for a period of up to five years. A jurisdiction may apply to renew a waiver at any time up to 180 days prior to the expiration of an existing approved waiver. An approved waiver does not waive a jurisdiction from its obligation to comply with the other requirements of the SB 1383 regulations including, but not limited to, promoting and providing information to generators about waste prevention, community composting, managing organic waste on site, and other means of recovering organic waste.

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On behalf of the Bolinas Community Public Utility District (“BCPUD”), I am submitting a Low Population Waiver application requesting waiver of the following requirements of Article 3 in 14 CCR 18984:

14 CCR 18984.4  
14 CCR 18984.5  
14 CCR 18984.6  
14 CCR 18984.9  
14 CCR 18984.10

and

any and all jurisdictional enforcement responsibilities applicable thereto.

The BCPUD holds the franchise for solid waste disposal within our jurisdictional boundary and Recology Sonoma-Marín is our franchisee. Bolinas is a remote, rural community on the Marin coast with a population of 1,483 people (per the 2020 Census). Our district provides water, sewer, and related utility services to 587 customers. In 2014, Bolinas disposed of far less than 5,000 tons of solid waste as detailed in the attached report prepared by Recology Sonoma-Marín: specifically, Bolinas disposed of 1,588 tons of solid waste that year. As such, we respectfully request a finding by CalRecycle that the BCPUD meets the requirements for low population waiver from the requirements of Article 3.

Please note that the BCPUD is not requesting waiver of other provisions of Article 3 (i.e., 14 CCR 18984.1, 18984.2, 18984.3, 18984.7 or 18984.8) because we (through our franchisee) already provide Three-Container Organic Waste Collection Services via containers that meet the color and labeling requirements of Article 3. Please note further that our district, in partnership with the Bolinas Fire Protection District, Stinson Beach County Water District, and the Stinson Beach Fire Department, established the Bolinas-Stinson Beach Resource Recovery Project, which operates a green waste processing center for the residents of Bolinas and Stinson Beach as a local repository for green waste, which encourages hazardous fuel reduction activities (thereby reducing fire danger in our communities) and reduces the carbon emissions that otherwise would be incurred if this material had to be transported to an out-of-town disposal site.
