BCPUD Resident Permit Parking Plan Committee Note to Board 6.7.24

In lieu of a formal verbal report for the June board meeting this note provides a brief summary of what our committee knows regarding the status of Bolinas parking ordinance development by the county. We hope to elaborate in July when we have more information.

- BCPUD staff have had conversations with the Department of Public Works (DPW)
 regarding the MOU between the sheriff's office and BCPUD for administering the
 permits. Staff have told us that DPW informed them that the county was now working
 on the MOU and that it would go to the Board of Supervisors mid-July.
- 2. Our committee has not heard anything from the county regarding the vehicle length parking restrictions which were also part of the Coastal Commission approval. These ordinances will help mitigate the loss of Measure X and hopefully help to calm the downtown streets.
- 3. We have asked Supervisor Rodoni for an update on the entire group of ordinances. In a DPW February email we were informed that the county was going to consolidate all the parking ordinances: current red zones, green zones and new permit program, vehicle length restrictions into one Bolinas ordinance. We do not know the status of this effort. We hope to hear from Supervisor Rodoni soon.

The work on the new ordinances started in February. We are concerned that it is now summer and we do not have them in place. Our committee planned to report more specific information in April, however, July now seems the soonest we may know something, with implementation further down the road. We appreciate the time that BCPUD staff have spent on the permit program and answering our questions, as well as BCPUD's continued support for this effort.
