## Bolinas Stinson Resource Recovery Report



## **General Operations**

The greenwaste Grind occurred on July 25<sup>th</sup> (thank you to Anvil builders for their assistance in getting the grinder to Bolinas)

West Marin Compost removed 500 yards of ground material so that the site could accept material coming in from fire fuel reduction projects.

Marin Wildfire Prevention Authority conducted a Community Green Waste Drop Off Day on August 1<sup>st</sup>.

Joe and Greg have been moving material and managing the compost piles.

The County of Marin Environmental Health conducted their quarterly Compostable Materials Handling Operation and Facility inspection on August 6<sup>th</sup>. Pleased to report that the site passed inspection.

## **Management Discussions**

The BCPUD met with George and Isaac from the Bolinas Fire Department on August 28<sup>th</sup> to discuss ongoing management of the RRP site with some main points being discussed:

- Daily site management needs additional support for the current RRP employees
- Continued financial discussions reaching out to Stinson Fire and Water for funds to help run the site, closing site more days, drop-off rates
- Equipment loader needs repair, old loader and tractor need to be removed.
- Compost what to do with surplus of compost. Looking into locations that will take the compost.

## Meetings

It was decided to first get our arms around the general operations of the site and get a plan in place and then convene a committee meeting with interested parties. Georgia, Belle, George and Isaac plan to meet with Jeff Creque and Joe Bracco on September 24<sup>th</sup> to continue discussions primarily related to the material on site.
