Re: Marin County Board of Supervisors Meeting

The *Staff Report* (attached) in Item 6 on the agenda of the BOS meeting outlines the request for BOS approval. The request matches what was submitted and approved by the Coastal Commission earlier this year. It asks for:

1. The introduction of the parking ordinances (permit and vehicle length)

2. Adoption of the resolutions applying the restrictions to Brighton Avenue and Wharf Road and

3. The authorization for the execution of the MOU with BCPUD for the administration of the parking permit program.

At the meeting, DPW staff asked that the Board approve #1 (the ordinances) and #3 (the MOU.) **The resolutions (#2)** will be brought back to the BOS for adoption at a later date. Just prior to the meeting, Wharf Road restrictions were found to need revision.

All members of the BOS voted to approve #1 and #3. A draft summary of the approved ordinances will be sent out as a notice to the *Marin IJ*. A second reading of those will occur at the 10/29/24 BOS meeting. Adoption of the resolutions for the parking restrictions will occur at a later date, we assume in November. We will be working with the county on the resolutions for Wharf Road which had shown incorrect areas for the proposed restrictions. With these ordinances, the county has developed a two phased process for adopting parking restrictions, adding a *resolution* component. which provides flexibility for future updates and revision. In this case it allowed the adoption of the ordinances to occur despite the problem with the area for restriction.
