Resident Permit Parking Plan Committee Update 12.07.24

This update is follow-up to the committee's November 20, 2024 report at the BCPUD Board of Directors meeting. At that time we reported that a Traffic Resolution for the recently passed parking ordinances was in process of further review. We can now say that County staff finalized the map and resolution wording to be submitted to the Marin County Board of Supervisors for final approval. Details are shown in the description below along with the map.

Description of the Traffic Layout Map

A Traffic Resolution Map (Bolinas Traffic Layout Map) is expected to be brought by the Department of Public Works (DPW) to the Marin County Board of Supervisors (BOS) for approval in January, the date of which is not yet known. The enabling ordinances were passed by the BOS in October. This Resolution details where restrictions will occur. A separate document matching the map will be submitted by DPW to the BOS further explaining the restrictions.

The map shows <u>22' vehicle length restrictions</u> on Brighton Avenue on the non-residential side of the street and on a portion of Wharf Road. On Wharf Road this restriction is in effect at all times due to the road narrowing toward the beach where there is no outlet. Brighton Avenue's restriction is during the hours of 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.

<u>Permit Parking hours are 2 a.m.- 5 a.m.</u> on the residential side of Brighton Avenue as shown. On Wharf Road, as shown, they are on the inland side south of the Museum to and including the last residential property. Beyond that point there are no permit restrictions on the inland side to the beach entrance. On the lagoon side two properties are under this restriction.

The area for the restrictions in the Resolution matches DPW's submission to the Coastal Commission, approved last February after several public review periods.
