3. Updates on pending Marin County Department of Public Works (DPW) Bolinas downtown parking ordinances.

Earlier today, the Marin County Department of Public Works (DPW) requested the Board of Supervisors (BOS) to adopt a resolution to establish the specific road segments and hours where and when the Downtown Bolinas parking restrictions will apply. Bolinas parking ordinances were introduced by DPW to the BOS at an October 15, 2024 meeting and adopted by consent on October 29, 2024. The ordinances establish a 22' vehicle length restriction and overnight permit program in downtown Bolinas. The DPW request was approved by the BOS. The agenda details to the vote included a DPW staff report, the proposed resolution and attachment - a map of the area covered by the resolution. Only portions of the downtown streets are subject to the parking ordinances. The map can be found on the Community page of the BCPUD website under the section for this committee. Prior meeting minutes discussing the plan are also found on the BCPUD website.

Signage for the ordinances will occur when BCPUD implements the permit plan. Members of the committee would like to see a "working group" formed that includes our members to discuss some of the key components of the permit plan with BCPUD. Because we have been working on these ordinances for more than 4 years, we think our participation will provide continuity to the process and help to facilitate getting it off the ground. The key areas to work with BCPUD on are: timeline; notification regarding program to eligible persons and community at large; total number of permits available; method of issuance; eligibility determination; existing special situations; and enforcement.

The committee agreed to have member Hirsch and Bowser represent the committee in this work group and report to the Board at their 01/15/25 meeting.
