- 3. Updates on implementation of Marin County Department of Public Works (DPW) Bolinas downtown parking ordinances.

On January 14, the Marin County Board of Supervisors (BOS) adopted the resolution to establish the specific road segments and hours where and when the Downtown Bolinas parking restrictions will apply. This was the final action needed for implementation. Only portions of the downtown streets are subject to the parking ordinances. Details of the plan and a map of the location of the ordinances can be found on the BCPUD website. Prior meeting minutes discussing the plan are also found on the BCPUD website.

BCPUD will issue parking permits to eligible residents and signage for the ordinances will occur when BCPUD completes their task. the permit plan. Committee members Bowser and Hirsch are working with BCPUD staff on this task which includes timeline; notification regarding program to eligible persons and community at large; determining total number of permits available; method of issuance; eligibility determination; how to deal with existing special situations; and enforcement. Because committee members been working on these ordinances for more than 4 years, it has been helpful to have their participation to provide continuity to the process and help to facilitate getting it off the ground.

So far the numbers of permits available has been confirmed with DPW, information has been sent to the community, eligible residents and neighboring businesses. The application for a permit is currently in process of being developed.

The hope is to get the ordinances in place before the summer, hopefully in May.

Members want to make sure that visitors are informed the parking changes. There has been press interest since the BOS January vote.

Discussion regarding enforcement included the need to get the County Park to coordinate with Sheriff's office regarding their parking site on Park Ave. near the tennis courts. Member Bowser is working on that issue.
