Dear Ms. Fies,

On behalf of the Bolinas Community Public Utility District (BCPUD) and the Bolinas Eucalyptus Project (BEP) applicant group, we are writing to formally withdraw and rescind our application for environmental review for the Bolinas Eucalyptus Project (P4643).

After careful evaluation over the past several months—and in coordination with the Bolinas Fire Protection District and the Marin Wildfire Prevention Authority (MWPA)—we have decided to pursue a phased hazard tree removal approach under the Governor’s Emergency Proclamation, rather than moving forward with the comprehensive CEQA Initial Study proposed by the County.

This alternative path allows the community to address immediate tree hazards while also creating the space to assess longterm landscape stability, slope conditions, and ecological function following several years of phased removal work conducted under the Emergency Proclamation.


Both BCPUD and the BEP are aligned in this decision and jointly support rescinding the BEP application at this time.

We appreciate the County’s efforts to develop a CEQA scope and proposal and thank you and your staff for the time and attention devoted to this project. We hope to reengage with the County in the future should additional tree removal be warranted and a more comprehensive habitat restoration effort be appropriate and feasible once phased hazard tree removal work has progressed.
